

MISSION TRIPS

1. The spring of 2009 a group of five individuals from Barbee went to Morning Star Ranch in Florence, Kansas to help with a fund raising event. The proceeds of this event were to help with scholarships for intercity children to attend the World Impact Summer Camps held at Morning Star.
2. Barbee again took a group of eleven volunteers to Morning Star Ranch in August 2009. This time the group helped to finish some building projects, replaced some floors, and spruced up one of the flower gardens.

Barbee took a team comprised of eighteen individuals (15 adults and three students) on a mission trip to work with Jerry Wright, Native Adult and Youth Ministries, on the Navajo Reservation in Arizona. They left the parking lot in a 15 passenger van and an RV on the morning of Friday, July 30, 2010. They travelled to the Native American Navajo Reservation in Northeast Arizona to frame in a house for an elderly Navajo woman and to paint a building on the Hopi Reservation. They returned to Excelsior Springs on August 8th.
