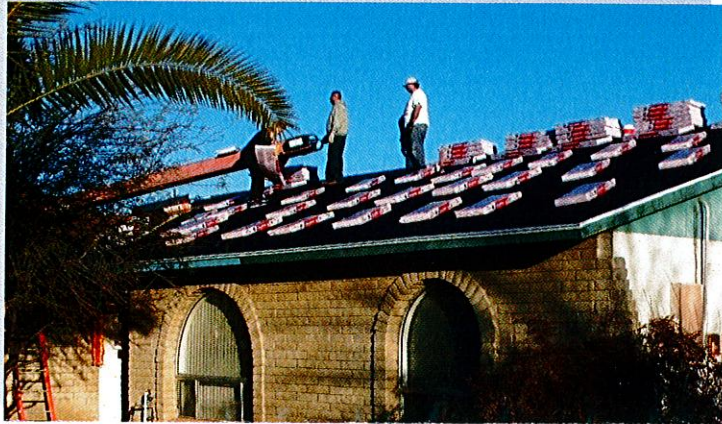




Wright's Spring Ministry Update

October brought a rare hail storm to the area where several of our missionaries live, so Mark and I along with sons of some of our missionary families were busy roofing several houses this winter. If one has to roof in Phoenix, the only time to do it is in the winter! We used and abused a few muscles that had become rather dormant!

Our first work team of 2011 found us roughing in the plumbing for Barbara Ranger's house near Pionon. The day we left Phoenix with the team, we had to wait for the interstate to open due to a snow storm. While it was a cold week, 15 degrees one night, we had plenty of wood to burn to keep us warm. Mark was in charge of installing the supply lines while I installed the drain lines.



Our second team hung over 100 sheets of 4ft by 12ft drywall, taped most of the seams and coated the screw indentations with drywall compound. We still need a couple more coats of drywall compound put on before texturing and painting. Attic insulation was also installed. Our goal is to complete this project in July.
